INTRODUCTION :

More than a century ago, Wanless Hospital began as a single bedded dispensary. Sir William Wanless was a Canadian doctor who came as a missionary to India. Since those beginnings, the hospital has steadily grown into the 550 bedded Miraj Medical Centre (MMC). Now it is time to move to the future in providing a Christian Medical College and Research Centre in Miraj, India. MMC now serves a local population 1,75,000, with a catchment area of 10 million people, an area of 250 km, including portions of four states.

The Mission of MMC is, "Healing, Teaching & Preaching".

MILESTONES OF MIRAJ MEDICAL CENTRE :

- 1894 : Establishment of Wanless Hospital, Miraj Medical Centre, Miraj.
- 1910 : Medical School for LMP (Licentiate Medical Practitioner)
- 1930 : School of Nursing
- 1931-1961 : Medical School for LCPS (Licentiate College of Physician Surgeon)
- 1962-2004 : MBBS Medical Course (Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery)
- 1976 : School of Allied Health Professional Courses (Paramedical)
- 1979 : Institute of Pharmacy
- 1986 : College of Nursing
- 1988 : Post Graduate Courses of National Board Examinations, New Delhi.
- 2000 : Post Graduate Courses of CPS, Mumbai.

Through the years of affiliation with the Maharashtra Government Medical College, Miraj MMC graduated 120 Christian doctors who are now working in most of the Mission Hospitals in India.

CURRENT STATUS :

Miraj Medical Centre (MMC) provides 550 patient beds. This includes 27 basic speciality units and 12 super speciality units. Speciality units include Surgery, Medicine, OB/GYN, Paediatrics, Orthopedics, Anaesthesia, ENT and Ophthalmology, other allied subject. Super speciality units include Cardio-Thoracic Surgery, Cardiology, Neurosciences, Urology, Nephrology and Plastic Surgery, Open Heart Surgery, Kidney Transplants, Joint replacements & Endoscopies are done. MMC is a Tertiary Care Centre.

Ancillary services include Pathology, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Haematology and Blood Bank. There is a well equipped Radiodiagnosis Department, Cardiac-Catheter Lab, Haemodialysis, Radiotherapy Unit and Centre for HIV/AIDS patients, Molecular Lab.

In keeping with our commitment to serve low economic patients, 11 % of our care is provided at no cost to the patient. Our outreach to villages through the Community Health Department provides additional care to rural areas & MMC promotes Woman Empowerment Programmes.

Chaplaincy Counselling Centre meets Spiritual & Counselling needs of students & staff.

FUTURE PLANS :

Miraj Medical Centre Society has applied to the Medical Council of India (MCI) for permission to establish a Christian Medical College and Research Centre (CMCRC) Miraj. Various statutory governing bodies such as :

- Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik (MUHS).
- Director Medical Education Research (DMER) Govt. of Maharashtra, Mumbai.
- Ministry of Family Welfare Medical Education, Govt. of India, New Delhi.

The above statutory bodies have approved & granted all necessary permission & requirements to start CMCRC. The first inspection by MCI New Delhi will be completed by December 2011.

MMC owns the required 27 acres of land. It has the required 300 beds minimum, complete infrastructure, teaching staff and supportive services as per MCI requirements.

Miraj Medical Centre Society will establish a Christian Minority CMCRC of 100 seats (No. of students accepted for admission) each year. Admissions for CMCRC will begin tentatively from the academic year 2012 - 2013.

The approximate cost for the establishment of CMCRC will be ₹ 40 crores (USD 11 million \$). These funds cover cost of construction & development of Christian Medical College Buildings, Hostel for boys & girls of capacity of 500 each, staff quarters for teaching & non-teaching faculties, development of College Library, Auditorium, Computer Rooms, development & establishment of pre-clinical departments of Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry & Para clinical departments like Microbiology, Pharmacology, Pathology, Forensic Medicine & clinical departments like Surgery & Allied, Medicine & Allied, Ob. Gyn. & Allied, Paediatric & Allied, Ancillary Dept. & other required infrastructure as per Medical Council of India requirements procurement of instruments, equipments, furniture, books, journals & periodicals. It is projected that after completion of 5 years, CMCRC will be financially independent and self supporting.

BENEFITS OF CMCRC :

- Continue to serve the Lord in providing Christian services to the community.
- Benefit dioceses by serving on the CMCRC Board of Administration and sponsoring their students.
- Promote on-going relationships with PCUSA, CNISynode & other organisations.
- Provide additional employment for the eligible skilled and unskilled persons.
- Community upliftment.
- Opportunity for christian students to get medical education.
